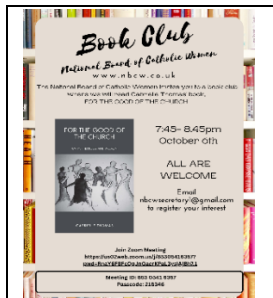
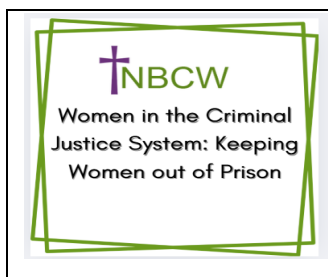


CAFOD Family Fast Day October 3rd
